PARALYMPICS 2024 SUCCESS

GB's 215-strong squad finished second in the medal table behind China with 124 medals (49 golds, 44 silvers and 31 bronzes) - comfortably achieving the UK Sport target of 100-140.

Great Britain matched their overall medal total from Tokyo three years ago, but won eight more golds in Paris. In fact, 49 gold medals is ParalympicsGB's highest tally since Rio 2016 - where they won 64 golds - and
