Supporting People with Learning Difficulties

We support people who have a learning disability or learning difficulty through one-to-one appointments, assisting in meetings and contacting organisations. Our approach is to run a person-centred service giving information, guidance and support. The Learning Difficulty Pathway has recently offered support with welfare benefits, grant applications and day-to-day finances at our weekly correspondence drop-in sessions. We also arrange monthly workshops and run a life admin course for people with ADHD.

July Workshop Recap: SeeAbility

SeeAbility joined us to share information

about opticians specifically trained to support people with learning disabilities or difficulties. More info here.

August Workshop: First Aid

The British Red Cross
delivered a fantastic first aid
session, with demonstrations on choking,
burns, recovery position, CPR, defibrillator use,
and treating deep wounds. Our speaker
Pam also gave some excellent tips, including

unlocking the front door before starting CPR to allow quick access for emergency services.



September Workshop: Know Your Numbers

We ran a blood pressure workshop as part of the Know Your Numbers campaign. Alongside this, Enable launched a free 12-week weight management programme in central Bromley for people with a learning

disability and a BMI of 30 or above.
