
energy you've brought to each session.






BWYC Events update



Young Carers grant for aged 16+

BWYC offers dedicated transition support for young carers, designed to help you navigate important life changes. Whether you're moving to a new secondary school, starting university, or planning for your future, we're here to guide and support you every step of the way.

Transition Support for Young Carers

There are grants available from the **Carers Trust Carers Grant Fund for any** carers, aged 16+. Carers can apply for grants of up to £400 for items or activities that will benefit them in their caring role. This could be for a range of things including driving lessons, help to buy items for the home giving a break from your caring role. If you are interested in applying for this grant, please contact us!

Emotional Support

Please remember that we are available for emotional support and someone to talk to if you need it. If you have any concerns about your mental health/your caring situation or if you just want to talk about things going on in your life or would like to be signposted to other services, we are here for you.
